Ray Siegrist Scholarship

Background

This scholarship program was established in 2002 to recognize the contributions & commitment of Mr. Ray Siegrist to the coaches and athletes of Bergen County high school athletic programs. As a coach, member of the BCCA Executive Board, and most important, as Executive Treasurer of the BCCA, Ray always demonstrated the BCCA needs to give back to the athletes and coaches wherever and whenever it can. The establishment and growth of the Lou Lanzalotto Scholarship Fund can be directly attributed to his advocacy. Ray knew the importance of first-rate coaching and recognized how superior high school coaches make the difference in budding student athletes. He knew the importance of scholastic sports in developing the positive morals and characteristics needed to be a contributing member of society. In short, he knew the value of high school athletics.

Purpose

This scholarship program was established to recognize the contributions BCCA members make to the high school experience in preparing student athletes for post-secondary education. It recognizes athletes who understand the value of high school athletics in both work and deed.

Award

Scholarships of \$1000.00 will be awarded. The scholarship is to be used for expenses associated with attendance at a 4-year college or university. Scholarship recipients will be notified by phone or mail. A check will be mailed when official enrollment to an accredited institution is provided.

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Son or daughter of a member of the Bergen County Coaches Association.
- 2. Senior in high school graduating in the year the scholarship is awarded.
- 3. Plan to attend 4-year College or university in same year scholarship is awarded.
- 4. Earned a varsity letter in at least one high school sport.
- 5. Completed Application forms/answer to essay question.

Student Considerations

- 1. 350-750 word essay (maximum 2 pages in size 14 font) on "What playing sports in high school has meant to me."
- 2. Participation in high school athletics.
- 3. Leadership & honors/awards in high school athletics.
- 4. Scholarship: GPA and transcript. Include 7th semester transcript

Parent Consideration

- 1. Contributions to Bergen County Coaches Association
- 2. Number of years coaching high school sports. Varsity, Junior Varsity and Freshman levels.

Application Procedure
