It is named after him to recognize one of the greatest coaches of all time. Mac is in the New Jersey Coaches Hall of Fame & the NVD Hall of Fame. Mac has won numerous championships under the Norsemen banner. After retirement from Demarest, Mac retired to his wife's hometown in Kansas and becomes a Hall of Fame Coach for football - winning a National football title for Madison, Kansas. The Madison Stadium now bares his name. Almost fully out of retirement, Fred now coaches his grandsons Casey and Drew. To many, Mac was the greatest motivators and innovative Coach athletes ever knew. To others, Mac was the best technical coach they ever knew in the field events. To opponents, he was the most fierce and intense person they had ever met. But to me, I think his greatest asset as a coach and mentor was his ability to see in people what they could not see themselves. I am proud to have been chosen as the successor of his program.
